Winter Wildlife Safari from Big Sky or Bozeman

Wolves howling, Diamond dust, Pure blue skies, Eagles' cries
Yellowstone in winter is a wonderful once-in-a-lifetime experience!

The northern part of Yellowstone is home to the largest herds of Big Game in all of North America—elk, bison, wolves, bears, and more! October through June is prime time for watching gray wolves together with all of the other species that have lived in northern Yellowstone for the past 8,000 years.

From Big Sky or Bozeman your departure will be at 7 AM. You will follow the 200 year old Lewis and Clark Trail over Bozeman Pass to the eastern side of the Rocky Mountains. After traveling through beautiful Paradise Valley you will arrive at the North entrance to Yellowstone. We will take a coffee and restroom break at the Tumbleweed Café, home to Yellowstone's best food. Please bring your lunch or purchase food at the Tumbleweed Café.

Next you will enter Yellowstone through the historic Roosevelt Arch. While searching for antelope and bighorn sheep your guide will help you understand the importance of Yellowstone in our world. After passing through Mammoth we will head for the meadows of Lamar Valley. If lucky wolves, bison, fox, golden or bald eagles, and much more will await our cameras and spotting scopes.

To maximize sightseeing time please plan for a field lunch. Your guide will stop at a convenient location with a field restroom. Your tour will return to Gardiner in the afternoon for a quick view of mysteriously beautiful Palette Springs. For driving safety you will head back to Big Sky or Bozeman to return before dark.

We provide spotting scopes and binoculars so you can search for those elusive wolves or bighorns. We also supply interpretation materials, first aid gear, and all of the other group items you will need. Warm drinks are also included and field snacks.

You are responsible for your own personal clothing and gear. We recommend that you dress in layers. Park entrance fees, guide gratuity, and lunch are not included. Please advise if you have any food allergies and health conditions. Some meals may be served inside and itineraries may need to be adjusted if conditions require. Reservations are required.

To Make a Reservation

The base rate for a safari is \$625 per day for your family with 1-4 adults from Big Sky or \$575 from Bozeman. This includes the services of a private National Park Service Licensed guide, transportation to/ from your hotel in the Big Sky or Bozeman, Montana, field snacks and drinks, use of high quality spotting scopes and binoculars, and much more. An additional adult is \$85 per person. For more than 6 people two vehicles might need to be used for winter driving safety. Group and educational rates also available. Please contact us with your details so we can respond with a quotation.

To confirm your safari guide reservation

Please remit a check for the first day's safari fee to YGA, PO Box 746, Bozeman, MT 59771 USA. We also accept wires and international bank drafts. For your protection and to keep safari fees as reasonable as possible we do not accept credit cards. The final remaining balance will be due three weeks before your arrival. Since all of our trips are tailored to meet your individual needs detailed price quotations will be provided once we have all of the details of your trip. After receiving your payment we will contact you to confirm arrangements for the day of your trip. Please send us your hotel itinerary and cell phone contact number so we can contact you if necessary after you depart on your trip. Also, please be sure to check with us for any last minute news from the field.

Our cancellation policies are flexible up to three weeks before arrival. We understand that family emergencies can happen. If the weather should be very bad on the day of your trip we will also reschedule or refund your payment- we prefer to treat you with respect and the reality is that we do not want you out in a major snowstorm without being able to see anything. However, sudden cancellations "just because" are not acceptable and no refunds will be made.

We can assist you with wheelchair and other special needs arrangements as well. Please be sure to call us in advance to be sure all the arrangements for your family are just as you would like them to be.
